

## **Aurora Dream Tours**

### **Winter Itinerary C2 (5 days and 4 nights)**

#### **Day 1 / Airport Pick-Up / Aurora Hunting by Car**

1. Arrival.
2. Airport pick-up: Our company will welcome you and pick you up at the Yellowknife Airport.
3. Hotel check-in.
4. Personal leisure time during the afternoon and evening.
5. First night Aurora viewing by car: We will visit at least two different lake-view locations and experience the magic of the Northern Lights. While waiting for the Aurora, you can enjoy complimentary hot beverages and snacks. We also provide free Aurora photography services each night.

Pick-up time is around 9:30–10:30 PM. This activity lasts approximately 4 hours. At the end of the tour, we will drop you off at your hotel or BnB.

#### **Day 2 / Dog Sledding / City Tour / Aurora Viewing in both Dream Cabin & Aboriginal Teepees**

1. Personal leisure time in the morning. If you would like to join any optional daytime activities, please let us know in advance when booking.
2. Traditional dog sledding starts around 1:00–2:00 PM. This activity lasts approximately 30 minutes. This is our most popular outdoor activity—don't miss this amazing opportunity! Come and meet our dogs, and let our experienced mushers guide you on a comfortable and safe ride.

On this tour, our musher will drive one large sled that can accommodate up to 6–7 adults at a time. Enjoy an exciting yet cozy ride through snowy trails across the frozen lake.

3. The city tour starts around 2:00–3:00 PM after dog sledding. The bus will take you to the main monuments and attractions. Experience the true northern culture that Yellowknife has to offer.

You will visit the Heritage Museum and the Northern Frontier Visitors Centre, where you can receive a “North of 60” certificate and a Yellowknife pin. You will also enjoy a scenic drive through the unique downtown core to the Old Town historic district.

We will stop at Pilot’s Monument, where you can climb to the top and take in the vast surrounding landscape. From the top, you’ll enjoy a panoramic view of Yellowknife Bay and the city skyline—one of visitors’ favorite sights. This location is also popular for landscape photos and portraits.

Our experienced tour guide will point out attractions and share stories about the history of Yellowknife. After the tour, we will drop you off at your hotel.

4. Second night Aurora viewing in the Dream Cabin and Aboriginal teepees: Explore the Aurora Borealis in our Dream Cabin and traditional teepees. These unique northern features will create an unforgettable experience.

While waiting for the Aurora, you can enjoy complimentary hot beverages and late-night snacks. Pick-up time is around 9:30–10:30 PM. This activity lasts approximately 4 hours. At the end of the tour, we will drop you off at your hotel.

## **Day 3 / Winter Sledding / Ice Fishing / Snowmobiling / Aurora Hunting by Car**

1. Winter sledding starts around 11:00 AM. We will pick you up from your hotel lobby. Enjoy this classic winter activity as you slide down snowy hills. It is one of the most fun and exciting ways to enjoy the snow, suitable for all ages.

2. After sledding, we will begin ice fishing. This activity lasts approximately 2 hours, and a fresh wild northern fish lunch is included.

This traditional and popular winter activity takes place on Great Slave Lake, where we have set up an Aboriginal ice fishing net. We will demonstrate how this activity is done, making it a great educational experience for both children and adults. After fishing, you can enjoy a freshly prepared northern fish lunch.

3. At around 1:30 PM, after lunch, we will begin snowmobiling. This activity lasts approximately 1 hour. Snowmobiles are one of the most flexible, quick, and easy ways to travel on snow. Enjoy your own ride as you explore the scenic surroundings of Great Slave Lake.

After the activities, we will drop you off at your hotel.

4. 3rd night Aurora viewing by car: We will visit at least two different lake-view locations again to experience the Northern Lights. Complimentary hot beverages, snacks, and free Aurora photography services are included.

Pick-up time is around 9:30–10:30 PM. This activity lasts approximately 4 hours. At the end of the tour, we will drop you off at your hotel or BnB.

## **Day 4 / Ice Cave / Aurora Viewing in both Dream Cabin & Aboriginal Teepees**

1. Ice Cave tour starts around 1:00–2:00 PM. Professional guides will ensure your safety at all times before, during, and after this adventure. The entire tour lasts approximately 1.5 hours and involves walking.

Ice caves are an amazing natural phenomenon and a must-see during winter tours in Yellowknife. You will see tunnels, cracks, and stunning natural formations.

2. The final night Aurora viewing in the Aurora Dream Cabin and Aboriginal teepees: Explore the Aurora Borealis in our Dream Cabin and traditional teepees. These unique northern features will create an unforgettable experience.

While waiting for the Aurora, you can enjoy complimentary hot beverages and late-night snacks. Pick-up time is around 9:30–10:30 PM. This activity lasts approximately 4 hours. At the end of the tour, we will drop you off at your hotel.

## **Day 5 / Departure**

We will transfer you to the airport 2 hours prior to your departure flight. Pick-up will be from your hotel lobby.
